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IO 5 - Description

1. **Syllabus** built upon materials created in IO2 – IO3- IO4 aiming in field-based intensive study activities.
2. **Focused** on users of the on-line module users (project students) **and** stakeholders that collaborate with the partner.
3. **Multi-disciplinary group** (*rural development, agricultural sciences, environmental science, social science, marketing and business, spatial planning, ecology, biology, forestry*)
4. **Activities in field** on-farm communication and interaction with local rural actors.
5. **Aim**
 - test the educational material on field
 - acquire further knowledge from communication with end users.
6. **Start** October 2021 as an IO, **programmed** for July 2022 in Pindos mt. (7 days)

□ IO 5 - Tasks

Task 1. To draft a general outline of the syllabus with a list of topics that the partnership can address and options of the delivery with their pedagogical underpinning.

Task 2. To create a programme of activities, in-class and in-field, that supports participants' mastery of the learning outcomes. The programme will build upon the theoretical foundations provided in IO2.

Task 3. To finalise the syllabus and create the content material (slides, interactive activities, individual and group tasks etc.). Special attention will be given to the assessment criteria of knowledge, skills and competencies of the participating students according to the learning outcomes.
