1 - <u>Elaboration</u> a general outline of the syllabus

- ✓ a general outline of the syllabus will be draft of UTH Applicant-UTH and PO1-CIHEAM IAMM
- All partners contribute and decide on a specific pedagogical approach best suited to the learning outcomes defined the decided outline with stakeholders.

2 – <u>Create</u> a programme of activities, inclass and in-field

The programme of activities, in-class and in-field, supports participants' mastery of the learning outcomes. Using the educational materials developed to IO2, the programme supports the proposed learning outputs which are coming from the educational material already produced in IO2

3 – Finalise the syllabus and create the material

RUR'up partners decide and create the necessary material (slides, interactive activities, individual and group tasks etc.), and the assessment criteria of knowledge, skills and competencies of the participating students according to the learning outcomes, both at the beginning and the end of the summer school.
