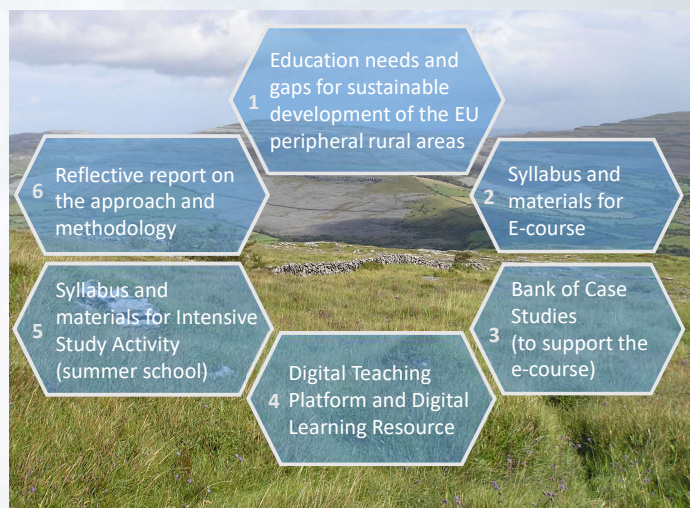

Major educational activities:

- E-course - a foundation for the Summer School, students come as regional experts in participatory innovation process to engage in a multi-cultural and multidisciplinary hands-on learning
- 70 students from 7 countries enrolled in spring 2022
- 5 Modules offered via a special e-learning interactive platform



- An intensive in-field **Summer School** with participating from 7 European HE institutions in Pindos mountain area, Greece, July 2022
- Several (online) workshops on modern pedagogy and its application in developing the courses and materials for educators
